Dear Parent,

We are very excited to be able to take the children to visit Beamish Museum on **Wednesday 23rd November**. We have been studying 'World War Two and this is a fantastic opportunity which will allow the children to experience, first hand, what life was like during this time.

The day trip to Beamish is an annual visit for Year 6 pupils at Broadway - and each year all staff and pupils make the effort to 'dress' as if they were from this period in history. We are therefore hoping this year will follow suit; the children are invited to **dress as World War 2 evacuees**.

Examples of outfits would be:

Boys: flat cap, waistcoat, jumper, trousers.

Girls: head scarf, dress or dungarees, shawl.

The Internet will also give you some excellent ideas for outfits.

On the day of the visit, children will need to come to school at their normal time, dressed in their costume. They will need a packed lunch (please adjust dinner money accordingly), drinks carried in a bag and a waterproof coat in case of bad weather.

School is heavily subsidising this trip but a voluntary **£5.50** contribution would be appreciated towards transport and entry costs. You can pay this via the Teachers2Parents app. A link will be sent to you.

Children will return from the trip at approximately **4:00pm** (we will send a text when we are 10 minutes away). Please ensure that your child knows how they are getting home and inform us on the slip below.
