Staff Self-Testing

Primary school staff are now able to test themselves twice a week with lateral flow devices. This programme of testing is designed to detect positive cases of COVID-19 amongst people who don't show any symptoms and is an added control measure on top of our current safety procedures. If any staff member tests positive, we will work with Public Health to determine close contacts. We may have to contact you at short notice to inform you that your child needs to self-isolate.

PE Kit

On your child's PE day, they must come to school wearing their uniform top half and joggers and trainers bottom half.

Homework and Laptops

Staff will shortly be setting homework for children, which will be online using the same programmes we used during the school closures. All children who have loaned a laptop from us can keep them for now.

Cycles and Scooters
