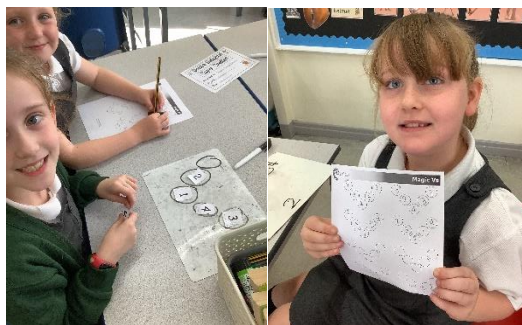


## Parents Evening

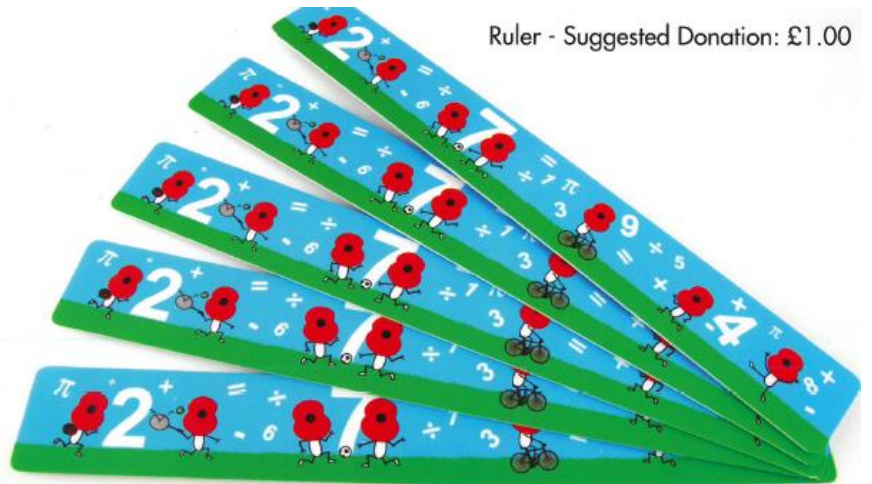

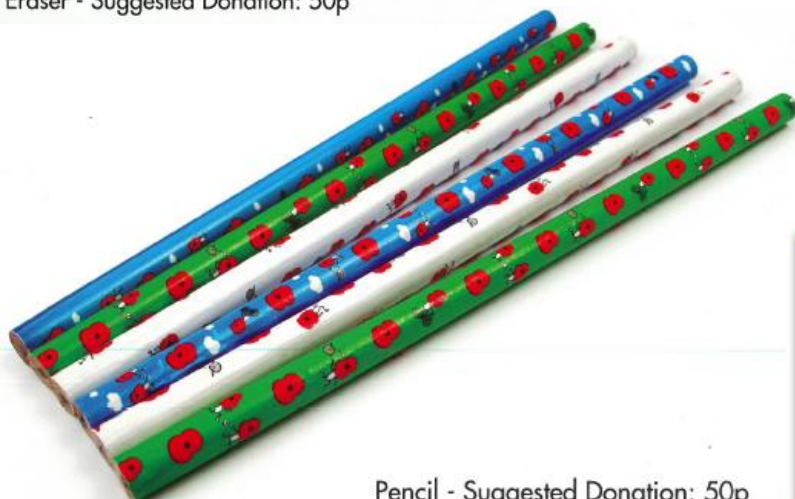
